

Privacy Policy

Nook Tables ("Nook Tables," "we," "us," or "our") respects your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, why we collect it, how we use it, and the choices available to you when you use the Nook Tables platform at www.nooktables.app.

By using Nook Tables, you acknowledge the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Information We Collect

Account Information

- Name
- Email address
- Date of birth or age
- Gender
- Profile/display photo
- Selected city
- Coffee and meetup preferences

Location Information

Nook Tables uses location information to help you discover cafes, restaurants, tables, and meetups relevant to your area. Depending on the features you use and the permissions you provide, we may process your selected city, locations you search for or select, cafe/restaurant locations, and device location when you choose to use location-based functionality. We do not require continuous background location tracking unless a feature explicitly requires it and you provide the necessary permission.

Table and Meetup Information

- Selected cafe or restaurant
- Table date and time
- Arrival and departure time
- Meetup topic or "vibe"
- Payment preference
- Number of available seats
- Table description
- Requests to join tables
- Request approval or rejection status
- Tables hosted and joined

Ratings and Feedback

After participating in a table, users may be able to rate their experience or other participants. We may store these ratings and use them to calculate profile ratings and help maintain the quality and safety of the Nook Tables community.

Technical Information

When you use Nook Tables, certain technical information may be collected automatically, such as device type, browser type, IP address, operating system, pages or features used, timestamps, error logs, and similar diagnostic or analytics information.

2. How We Use Your Information

We may use your information to operate Nook Tables, create and manage your account, verify your email, display your profile, show relevant locations and tables, enable table requests and approvals, calculate ratings, send service-related notifications and emails, provide customer support, prevent misuse or fraudulent activity, improve our platform, troubleshoot technical issues, and understand how our services are used.

3. Information Visible to Other Users

Nook Tables is designed to help people meet over coffee and other social gatherings. Certain profile and table information may therefore be visible to other Nook Tables users. Depending on the feature, this may include your name, age, profile photo, rating, preferences, tables hosted or joined, meetup topic, table information, and other information you intentionally make available through your profile or a table. Your email address and other private account information are not intended to be publicly displayed to other users.

4. Location and Third-Party Map Services

Nook Tables may use third-party mapping and location services, including services used to search for cafes, restaurants, addresses, and other places. When these services are used, relevant search queries or location information may be processed by the applicable provider according to its own privacy policy.

5. Service Providers

We may use trusted third-party service providers to operate parts of Nook Tables, including hosting, cloud storage, email delivery, authentication, maps and location search, analytics, security, and other technical infrastructure. These providers may process information only as necessary to provide their services to us, subject to their applicable agreements and privacy practices.

6. How We Share Information

We do **not sell your personal information**. We may share limited information with service providers that help us operate Nook Tables, when required by law or a valid legal process, when necessary to protect the safety and rights of our users or the platform, or as part of a merger, acquisition, financing, restructuring, or transfer of the business. Information you intentionally make visible through your profile or tables may also be visible to other users as part of the normal operation of Nook Tables.

7. Data Security

We use reasonable technical and organizational measures designed to protect personal information from unauthorized access, loss, misuse, alteration, or disclosure. However, no internet service or electronic storage system can guarantee absolute security.

8. Data Retention

We retain personal information for as long as reasonably necessary to provide Nook Tables, maintain your account, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, enforce agreements, prevent abuse, and maintain platform security. Information may be deleted or anonymized when it is no longer reasonably required, subject to applicable legal and operational requirements.

9. Your Choices and Rights

Depending on applicable law, you may have rights regarding your personal information, including requesting access to, correction of, or deletion of certain information. You can also change certain profile information and location preferences through Nook Tables. Device-level location permissions can be controlled through your browser or device settings. If you would like to request deletion of your account or personal information and an in-app deletion option is not available, you may contact us using the details below.

10. Emails and Notifications

We may send transactional communications necessary to operate Nook Tables, including login or verification codes, table creation confirmations, table requests, request approvals or updates, meetup reminders, rating requests, security notices, and important account or service information. Where required, promotional communications will provide an appropriate method to unsubscribe.

11. Safety and User Interactions

Nook Tables facilitates connections between users but does not control the actions of individuals you choose to meet. Users should exercise appropriate judgment when meeting people in person and follow the safety guidance provided through the platform. Users can report inappropriate behaviour or safety concerns through Nook Tables where reporting functionality is available.

12. Children and Minimum Age

Nook Tables is intended for users aged **16 or older**. You must be at least 16 years old to create and use a Nook Tables account. If we learn that we have collected personal information from a person under 16, we may take reasonable steps to delete the information and close the account. Where applicable law requires parental or guardian consent for a user aged 16 or older, the user must have any consent required by that law before using the service.

13. Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy as Nook Tables develops or as legal, technical, or operational requirements change. When material changes are made, we may notify users through the platform, by email, or by updating the "Last Updated" date displayed above.
